

Ferret 1

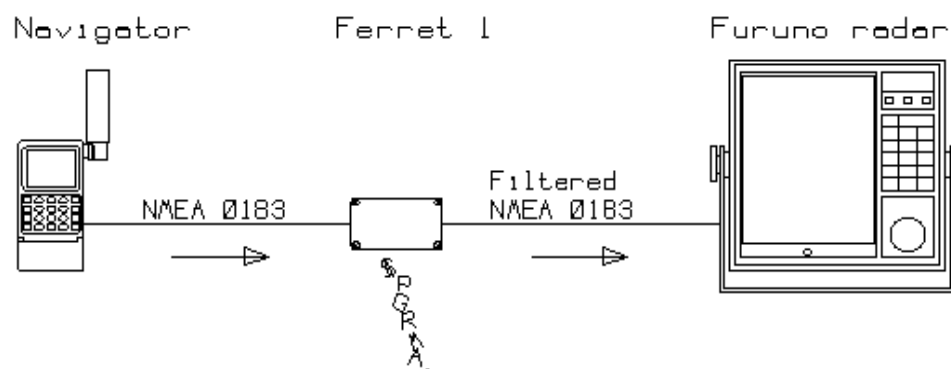


NMEA 0183 Filter. Removes selected sentences.

The Ferret (*Mustela Furo*) is a native of Asia and is also widely spread in Europe. It has a taste for journalists fingers and frogs. Ferrets are often named Fred!

Ferret 1 is a NMEA 0183 filter, with the ability to remove selected sentences from the NMEA message. This filter should be used when problems with NMEA communication is caused by specific sentences.

With this utility, the NMEA information is retransmitted except the selected sentences.
